YOU CAN MAKE CREDIT UNION HISTORY



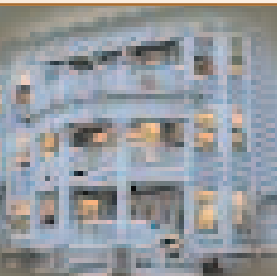
Preserve. Educate. Inspire.
